## **Professional Continuing Graduate Education for Science Educators at East Stroudsburg University's McMunn Planetarium**

This course is directed toward the practical aspects of effectively teaching the science of astronomy. The second day concentrates on content, and is mostly devoted to current discoveries and recent changes in our understanding of how the universe works.
